

World Trio Ensemble



The chamber music ensemble World Trio, formed by two marimba players Noriko Tsukagoshi, (Tokyo) and Silvio Wey (Luzern), and the soprano Corina Schranz (Luzern), distinguishes itself by virtuosity and outstanding interpretations; this young and highly promising trio connects voice and percussion in new ways. In 2007, they toured and demo-recorded “Just one World” from John Throwers and will be back in 2010 with a new two-part programme.

In the first part we hear new music written especially for World Trio. Japanese composer Hirotake Kitakata has dedicated a work to the Trio as well as John Thrower (Germany/Canada) and Stephan Hodel (Switzerland/London).

The second part consists of their own compositions in a singer/songwriter style, but is more experimental. Home made percussion instruments will be combined with marimba and voices.
